Support for Oxbridge Students

Preparation for Admissions Tests

These challenging tests help the universities choose between many highly academic applicants. A good score in admissions tests will increase your chance of getting an interview. At Bosworth you will get advice on preparing for these tests as well as learn tips and strategies to boost your score. We also offer STEP, PAT, MAT and TMUA exam preparation for students interested in Mathematics or Physics.

Individual Advice and Support

Weekly workshops with our Oxbridge Coordinator in Years 12 and 13 will guide you through the application process, from entry requirements through to personal statements and interview preparation. One-to-one meetings give you the individual advice and support you need, allowing you to develop your own action plan.

Academic Challenges and Competitions

To make your application stand out, you can carry out a specific research project or EPQ (Extended Project Qualification) on a topic related to your chosen course. You will also have the chance to enter competitions such as the Chemistry, Biology or Physics Olympiads and Maths Challenges. Bosworth students have previously won awards in essay, photography and national competitions.

Co-Curricular Programme

We offer a variety of co-curricular activities to develop your wider skills, including student leadership opportunities. A broad range of leadership, organisational and communication skills will increase your chances of being a successful university candidate.



Interview Preparation

You will be offered three sets of interviews:

- 1) Interview preparation and a practice interview with a specialist Oxbridge preparatory company.
- 2) A formal interview with external interviewer and expert in their field.
- 3) A practice interview with a senior member of staff where required, followed by individual feedback.

With the individual feedback and mock interviews, you will be more prepared and confident in your Oxbridge interview.

Regular Seminars

Oxford and Cambridge are looking for students who enjoy talking about their subject and being challenged to think 'on the spot'. At Bosworth you will have regular seminars with other students and our Oxbridge Coordinator, where you will gain confidence in discussing current issues in your areas of study. You will practise interview techniques and learn about admissions processes.

I spent 3 months preparing for my interview at Cambridge University and was given a lot of support by the Assistant Principal, the Vice Principal and a professional Engineer. This ultimately helped me to gain my place.
