## Bosworth Additional Costs

The majority of student costs are included in Bosworth fees but below are items that will be charged additionally, depending on the programme of study and student requirements.

Compulsory costs will be invoiced during the relevant term. Optional costs are generally payable in advance of the activity taking place. Parental permission will be sought for optional costs over £100.

	IELTS Exam fees*	£200 (students may be required to take this more than once)	Students who will require a visa to progress to university need to satisfy UK Visas & Immigration (UKVI) that they meet the requirements to study in the UK.
	UFP Exam fees	£135 per subject	Our cost includes the postage of certificates (UK or overseas).
	GCSE exam fees*	£40-£80 per subject	Exam fees are set by the exam boards and are subject to change. Our cost includes the postage of certificates (UK or overseas).
	A Level exam fees	£100-£160 per subject (depending on the Programme)	Exam fees are set by the exam boards and are subject to change. Our cost includes the postage of certificates (UK or overseas). Costs for reviews of marking are not included.

<b>Compulsory costs</b>	One-to-one exam invigilation	£15 per hour	Some candidates qualify for individual invigilation. This is an additional cost to the College which we pass on to the fee-payer. An extra additional charge is made for a reader or scribe where the candidate qualifies for special arrangements.
	Field Trip for Biology and Geography (GCSE and A Levels)	£250-£350	
*Our cost includes the postage of certificates (UK or overseas).			
<b>Optional costs</b>	One to One lessons / Additional Learning Support sessions	£75 per session	Students or parents may request regular additional one-to-one lessons.
	Music, Dance or other specialist lessons	£50-£100 per session	For private piano, cello, violin, flute, guitar or other specialist practical music lessons.
	Day or weekend trips (e.g., to London or Paris or optional class field trips)	Around £50 (day) / £400 (weekend) depending on destination and length of trip	Students sign up for trips at the fee advertised. Once a student signs up they will be charged even if they don't attend.
	The Duke of Edinburgh's Award; Bronze, Silver or Gold options	Gold - £750 / Silver: £350 / Bronze: £175	
	Half term / holiday trips (e.g., Florence, Madrid or Berlin Christmas market)	Around £600-£1000+ depending on destination and length of trip

Optional costs	Accommodation over Easter holidays	£480 per week for Year 11 and 13 (no activities) £840 per week for all other year groups (including full board and activities)	Including meals brunch and dinner.
	Activity programmes in holidays (half terms or Easter) **	As necessary	NB accommodation is free during half term holidays.
Consequential Costs	Replacement ID cards or room keys	£20 (ID card) and £40 (room key)	Boarding students are responsible for their room keys. We charge for the replacement if the student loses their key.
	Investigating / repairing a tampered with smoke alarm	£100	
	Any damages to college/boarding property	As necessary	We do not charge for genuinely accidental or minor damage.
	Emergency Guardianship	Guardianship fees are typically £250/day, full board	The School does not recommend nor require a student to have any specific guardianship. However, we reserve the right to require parents to place a student with a guardian through an AEGIS- accredited guardianship agency if emergency accommodation is required. Emergency arrangements can include cases of suspension or exclusion from the College.

## Other costs you may incur

These costs will vary and will generally not be charged by the College. Some of the costs will not be relevant and will depend on the course and the specific subjects you take. Some items can be bought second hand or borrowed so prices are only examples.

Stationery	Approximately £100 per year	GCSE students are provided with exercise books free of charge although pay a £1 replacement fee if they lose their book.
Textbooks	Approximately £200 per year	Students must purchase textbooks as advised by teachers.

Scientific calculator A Level Graphical calculator	Approximately £30 Approximately £85	Required for all students studying A-level and GCSE Mathematics. All GCSE, A-level Maths and Further Maths candidates work with the same calculator as teaching staff.

Visa costs (including Immigration Health Surcharge)	£800+ for Tier 4	International students will be required to pay visa application fees, and associated fees as required - such as the Immigration Healthcare Surcharge, Tuberculosis tests, fees to renew or extend a visa etc.  These fees are set and charged by the UK government and are subject to change.
